YEAR 9/ AGE 14 Start transition plan as part of MyPlan or EHC Plan review and update each year

CONSIDER

PLANNING WHAT My adult life Looks like

EMPLOYMENT:

- What will I do?
- · How will I get to that point?

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

- How will I spend my time?
- What will I access around me?

INDEPENDENCE

- Where will I live?
- · What skills will I need?

HEALTH

- How will I stay well?
- What will support look like as an adult?

YEAR 10/11 Up to age 16

- Continue transition plan
- · Look at different options
- Apply for Post-16 Education
- Review health & care needs and how they will be met as an adult

UP TO AGE 18

- Continue transition plan
- Plan for care and health for adult life, including assessment under the Care Act
- · Access post-16 education/training

TYPES OF POST-16 EDUCATION /TRAINING

ACADEMIC

- Qualification eg. A Levels
- School or college
- Leads to university or employment

VOCATIONAL

- Qualifications in work-related subject eg. BTEC
- College or training provider
- Leads to university or employment

EMPLOYMENT

- Focus on work related training eg. apprenticeship, traineeship, supported internship
- May need to take part in preparation programme first
- Leads to employment

LIFE SKILLS

- Activity focus
- Develop skills for adult life
- Leads to volunteering/ meaningful activity or employment

POST 19 YEARS OLD

- Continue transition plan
- Some young people will need more time to reach the next stage
- Adult health and care plan in place including for beyond education
- Focus on route to adulthood beyond education
