

Learn Sheffield Subject Specific Networks – How to Book

- Booking places for specific sessions is quick and easy – we use Eventbrite via the Learn Sheffield website.

(most colleagues will book on to all three meetings at the start of the year).

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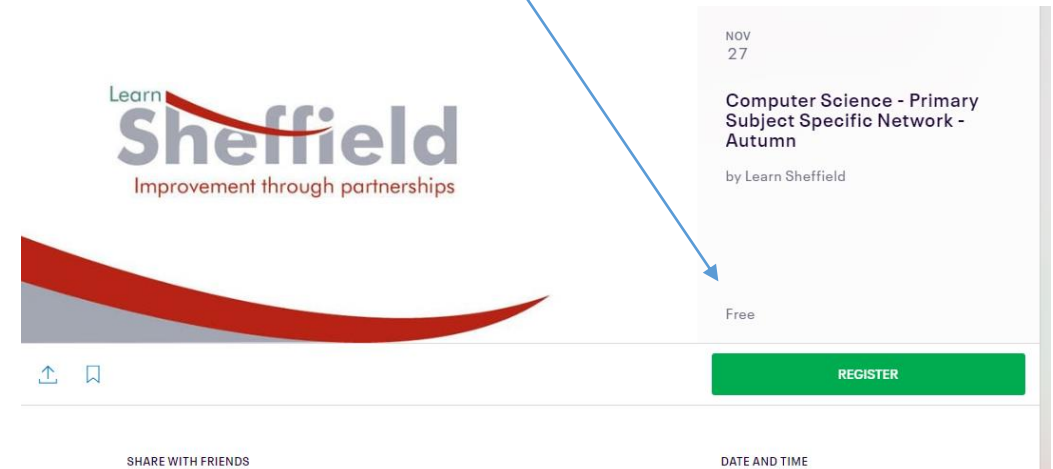
