



FREE Prevent Training for Sheffield Schools

The DfE published 'The Prevent Duty: Departmental advice for schools and childcare providers' in June 2015. It is essential that schools in all phases have attended training to ensure that each school understands the new statutory duty. Learn Sheffield is working with colleagues from across Sheffield City Council to provide **free training** for any Sheffield school that has not yet received training.

Each school has three free places and can book these at any of the sessions below. There are fifty places available for each session, which will last for two hours and include some examples of ways that the duty is being implemented in schools in a proportionate way.
