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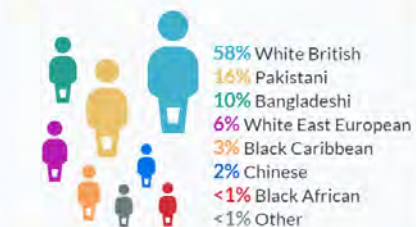

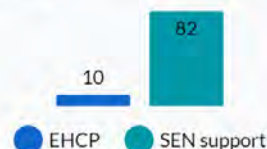

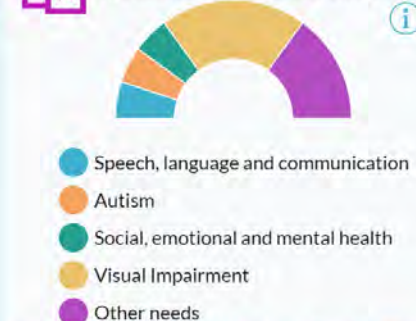

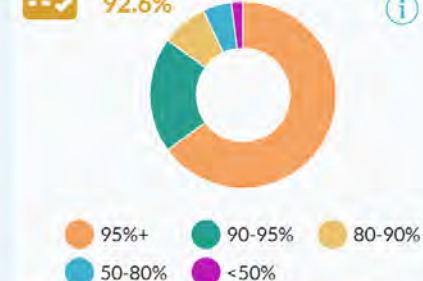

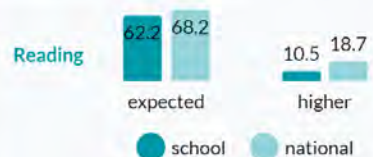


% of children working at the expected standard in phonics at the end of Y2 (2023)

Key Stage 1 assessment (age 7) i

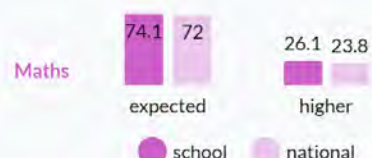
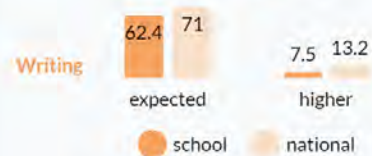
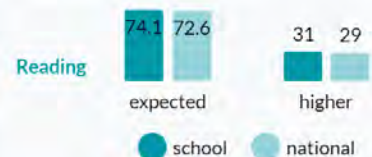
% of children achieving the expected / higher standard at Key Stage 1 (2023)

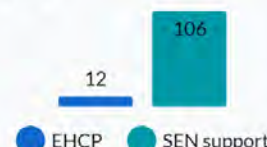

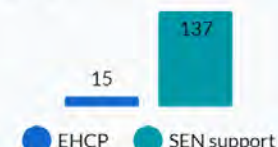
