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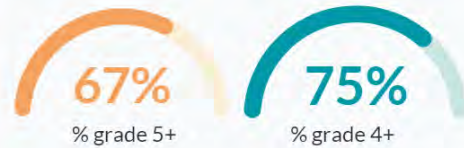

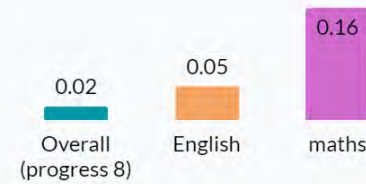
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Key Stage 4, grade 4+ / grade 5+ in English and maths (2023)



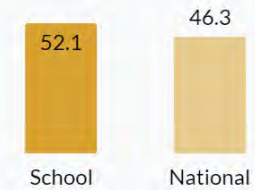

Key Stage 4, attainment 8 score (2023)



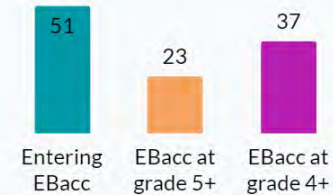

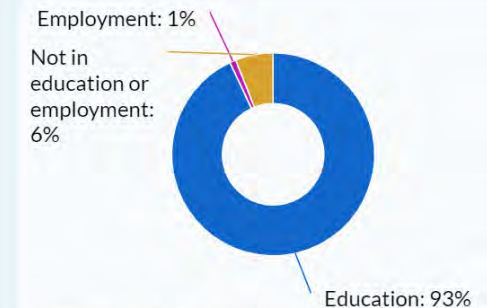

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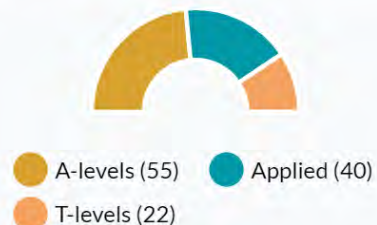
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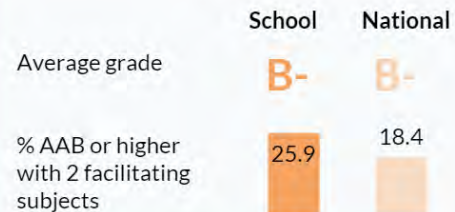
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Number of students by qualification type (2023)



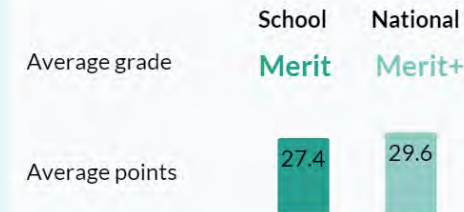

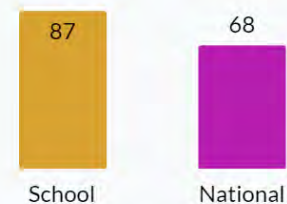

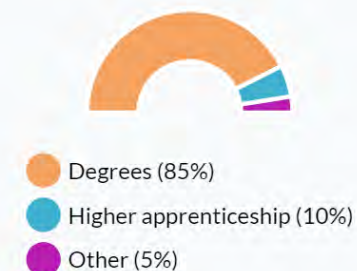
