• SEND Manifesto Proposal

As you will be aware, Learn Sheffield has been commissioned by SCC to support improvement in SEND in the city. We have now published two versions of the Sheffield SEND Manifesto Proposal:



Sheffield SEND Manifesto Proposal – Full Version / Overview Version

It has been developed with leaders from the Local Area Partnership and provides a starting point for the development of a long-term strategy for Sheffield. The next step is to collect further feedback, from across Sheffield, to inform the final content of the new strategy.

We will collect feedback in a number of ways but this work needs to happen quickly. We hope to publish a strategy by the end of September 2025, providing this has given enough opportunity for feedback.

The briefing also includes an update from our colleague Julie Kettlewell (Assistant Director of Huntington Research School) on the Research School Network. This includes signposting to <u>Clips</u> <u>from the Classroom</u>, which include videos of a practitioner explaining the evidence-base behind approaches and then demonstrating it in practice.

• KS2 Data Report

If you have signed up (no cost) for a KS2 report and summary dashboard on MATpad your reports should now be available to view. We have re-sent the user guide alongside this partnership note, which tells colleagues how to find the reports and how to remove pupils from your report (if you have newly arrived pupils for example).

For MATs there is also a MAT report available which covers Sheffield settings who have signed up. If you are interested in a report that includes non-Sheffield settings then please do get in touch. This will require some additional data sharing and may include a cost but can be done.
